Hello RSC,

We went to the storage room to assess the situation with the archives and it is clear that we have a good bit of work to do before the archives are going to be useful in any way. The panel agreed that the first step in this process will be to get all of the papers in clearly marked and categorically separated boxes so that the may be accessed readily. The categories will likely be: minutes, GRC Inc., Convention subcommittee, PI/PR, HI, then financials, and miscellaneous etc. We wanted to ask when would be the earliest we could access the conference center in March to make use of the large space and tables up until the RCM/GSR issues time. We also need to have as many organizationally minded volunteers available as possible. Once we have the archives in a proper order then deciding what we want digitized and scanned will be more practical. There is also no way to get a clear quote on hiring a person to scan the archives until this process has happened. Currently we have a standing offer to use an industrial scanner for free but the truth is we are not ready to use a regular scanner let alone an industrial one now. I would like to ask for an allowance with a cap of \$ 100 to purchase boxes, markers, staple removers, etc. for the purpose of streamlining and organizing the archives ASAP.

Issue Discussion Topic Workshop Summary Discussion #1 "Collaboration" December 1, 2012

The first session of this series of discussion topics was a great success and there were many ideas that came from having informal discussion about collaboration as an action principle. The meeting was opened in a general explanation of IDTs and how the discussions we have here, at the area level, can have an effect on the voice that our region and world levels of service steer their work at the upcoming conference. The rest of the meeting was devoted to a small group and large group style discussion. Before we split into small groups we brainstormed on things that we think of when we consider collaboration as it relates to the services in NA today. It became clear that the principle of collaboration applies to all aspects of our service work. Some that were listed as especially important were: Decision making, planning, teamwork, more effective message, subcommittees, mentoring, conventions, literature development, website work, service system changes, acknowledging a variety of perspectives, streamlining the service system, maximizing services, informing the fellowship on all levels. Each of these items actually branched out into other often-related aspects of NA service that tie into discussions and an ongoing process that we have been working on for years.

We then split into 2 small groups and had each group make up a practical project that would require collaboration. Group #1 came up with the idea of developing a local resource or tool that would aid in training and mentoring trusted servants for long-term continuity in service. The tool would be aimed at avoiding the typical burnout problem and slow process of learning to be involved that cause some members to loose interest in giving their time. Group #2 saw a need to foster a renewed discussion about traditions and concepts throughout the area. The effort was also geared toward sponsorship/servant guidance toward having a healthy service experience.

Each group then summarized their main points and realized that each main idea from each group was very similar. It was also at this point that we started to see some of the challenging aspects of collaboration with a common purpose. The chief challenge in collaboration at this workshop was finding a way to implement a project into our current service structure. There were starkly different philosophies toward what is acceptable and what is not acceptable as far as taking initiative to develop new and innovative service efforts. For example, on one side there is the traditional process of submitting ideas as topics and allowing the groups at the meeting level to discuss and create the terms of the effort. While on the other side this traditional way is not effective and sees projects like this as most effectively created at the area level.

As the meeting was ending it became clear that the discussion had sparked enthusiasm and interest to move forward with some of the ideas discussed such as developing a tool to aid in healthy NA Service. A few of the members committed to giving it some time and energy and possibly present an outline to the ASC.

As the facilitator and traffic director of the workshop, there were interesting points that showed up that tie into collaboration as an action principle. I found that the brainstorming guidelines were crucial in setting the ground rules for the workshop. All perspectives were listed and debate was avoided since the goal was not to find the "right" perspectives as much as it was to list <u>all</u> perspectives. We used a sticky paper post in board to write ideas as they came up and move forward. As each page filled up and was stuck on different portions of the walls we were able to see the bigger picture of the discussion of collaboration more clearly. Also sticking with the time schedule on the agenda and helping members keep their comments brief and to the point was effective. This was easier said then done. Their was a great deal of energy behind the discussion as it got going and at times it was clear that everyone their had a great deal of love for NA.

An interesting question came up again at the workshop about the service system project that really had me stumped at the workshop. The question was, "Is the service system projects going to take the voice away from the NA groups?". The question was also worded, "Is the service system project going to take the power away from the groups?" There is definitely a good deal of misinformation

about the SSP going around at meetings and in talks between individuals participating in NA. All of the information on the project is available on www.na.org.

Understanding the way that NAWS does business today must take into account that our fellowship is much larger than the Georgia region and our voice is but one of many. After talking with Nick at the World Service Office, who is one of the writers for the documents pertaining to service system change, I came out with some interesting perspective on group participation. Currently, according to NAWS of all of the thousands of groups in the world only about 50% participate in what we know of as an ASC. Currently that is the only way that a group may technically have a voice or exert any "power" on the work going on in further levels of service. What this means to me is that 50% of the groups have given their power or voice to the other 50% who are participating.

At the local level the new service system is actually designed to empower the groups to do more and more effectively. Having a plan-driven system as apposed to a delegated political type structure is definitely a huge change in the way we do things here at the Northeast Georgia area but in a large part of NA it is already happening. This challenge ties into the one that came from the project in the Collaboration workshop and will surely be more difficult for some areas than it will be for others.

This workshop leads nicely into the next workshop of the series on "Group Conscience", which will be on March 2, 2013. We will follow a similar agenda to once again get input from the fellowship about what is to come for NA. Thanks to all those who participated and I hope to see y'all again in March.

At the Regional business meeting, a consensus vote returned the position of Web Facilitator to the PR Sub-Committee. We will discuss this at more length during New Business. Also, during the PR Workshop/Training portion of our business meeting, we will be receiving training from Jim S. on managing our area meeting schedules on the Regional website, along with some additional website information.

Starting to get excited about GRCNA? Me too..... It's time for us to start planning our PR workshop for GRCNA! I hope you are all planning to attend and participate in the workshop!

To the GRSCNA and the NAASC admin and MASCNA members:

Please accept the following as my report on the PR booth that the region and North Atlanta area sponsored in October. If anyone has any comments, additions, or other follow up, please email myself or Mary Ellen (Regional PR chair) with those.

On Saturday and Sunday, Oct. 13 and 14, 2012, Narcotics Anonymous hosted a PR booth at the annual Atlanta Pride festival in Piedmont Park. The hours of the booth were 10:00am to 7:00pm on both days. The cost for renting the booth for two days (at the time payment was submitted on June 15) was \$450. The booth got a lot of traffic from the festival goers on both days. To my best estimate, based on tracking done during peak hours and non-peak hours, is that we had roughly between 100-140 people stop by the booth both days. A great number of these individuals actually stopped to ask questions, pick up some literature and meeting schedules, and overall were interested in what NA is and what NA does, whether it be for their personal info or for that of friends and/or family members.

The following literature was actually handed out. Please keep in mind that these numbers are based on us having 150 each of all of the IP's we carried, anywhere from 50-100 meeting schedules from all of

the areas located in the metropolitan Atlanta area, and also thirty copies of the pamphlet "Info About NA".

IP #1- Who, What, How, and Why......30 copies given out

IP #7- Am I An Addict......29 copies given out

IP #13- By Young Addicts, For Young Addicts......19 copies given out

IP #16- For The Newcomer......25 copies given out

IP #22- Welcome To NA......26 copies given out

NA: A Resource in your Community......42 copies given out

Info About NA......all 30 copies were given out

Although I do not have a specific number regarding meeting schedules, I will estimate that those numbers were roughly the same as the other literature given out. In addition, with the exception of several guests who were looking for certain areas and locations of meetings, most guests that picked up meeting schedules, picked up one of each. We also encouraged the volunteers in the booth to make guests aware of the other areas helpline numbers that were printed on the front of all of the meeting schedules, in addition to the 8-8-8- regional number.

Overall, I would rate the two day event a huge success for Narcotics Anonymous, in sofar as getting the message out there to those who stopped by with an interest in our program. It is also noteworthy to mention that we were the only 12 Step program represented at the Atlanta Pride festival. Having also participated in the booth back in 2010, I found my experience to be very positive, uplifting, and extremely gratifying.

I want to extend a special thank you to all of the volunteers that showed up to staff the booth. We were very well covered during all of the time slots that were available. We were never under staffed or not covered during the entire eighteen hours of the festival. I also need to give special thanks to Josh G., Liz L., Hal B., and Gerry H. These guys were instrumental in helping plan and coordinate the volunteers, and assisted me in being responsible for the booth at times when I was not present. Without their participation and involvement, it would have been difficult to achieve the success that we had. I also want to acknowledge and thank Kim N. and Wayne D. from the North Atlanta area. It was Kim and myself that initiated the possibility of doing this event during the early months of this year, and her encouragement to me in planning and coordination was immensely important. Wayne was responsible for getting us most of the IP's that we needed to supplement what we already had from the regional inventory. He also provided all of the meeting schedules for the remaining areas of metro Atlanta, with the exception of Marietta, which Justin T. provided, and I'm grateful to him as well.

I would like to see the region participate in this event next year. I hope this report helps to some degree to assess whether or not it is worthwhile to spend the money to be able to do this event. I realize that the monies spent are great, but I also look at the overall response to the booth, and I have to say that we accomplished our goal of being present, getting the message of NA out to anyone interested, answering questions about the program, and also giving some feedback in other areas, such as what is listed on the community referral page in the PR handbook. It is my understanding from speaking to Mary Ellen earlier, that if we get in on this event a bit earlier, that the cost of the booth would be less than what we paid this year. I believe and I hope the region will look into this. I will be more than happy to monitor the Atlanta Pride website and to keep Mary Ellen and the region informed as to the dates of the next festival (next October), the costs of the rental of the booth, etc.

Hello Georgia Region,

My report this region is mostly from NAWS updates and WSC participants updates.

Since the last Region I received an update from the WSO that they were forming a selected "Core Group" of N.A. communities to begin controlled field testing of the GSU's and LSU's who agreed to form lsu's and gsu's exactly as those described in the

Service system proposals. There are also general field testing going on around the world Where there are some communities that are trying parts of the proposals. There is a field testing frame posted to the Service system web page that explains the field test in detail.

The site for those of you who may not have it is www.na.org/servicesystem. There may be some areas that are participating in the core group or that are utilizing parts of the proposals in general in the state of Georgia but I do not know who they are. (I thought I heard Jason say at the Last region they were trying some of the proposals.)

The traditions book project plan was approved and identified as a priority literature project at WSC 2012. For history purposes the project came about as a response to a WSC 2010 motion and a 2011 fellowship wide literature survey. I report that because so many people have called and asked me how the idea of a tradition book came about and stated their fears about such a book. The tradition project focus for the 2012-2014 conference cycle will be to gather ideas and source material for the book and to work toward identifying fellowship consensus about what the book should look like. To start discussion the project group has 1. Developed a session profile and PowerPoint presentation for local workshops. 2. Set up online submission area for workshop responses, and 3. will launch a traditions book discussion board in early 2013. so there appears a lot of room and time for input. You can access this info at www.na.org/tradition. You can also retrieve this information from the November and December NAWS updates online. IDT's for the 2012-2014 conference cycle are A. Collaboration. B. Group Conscience. C. Supporting our vision. You can find session outlines and power points at www.na.org/idt The WSO is asking our region to ask our activity chair to go to www.na.org/events and list any new years eve activity beingnheld in our region. They are trying to cooperate with a request from the U S OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY who want to create a recovery new years eve happenings. Since we do not have a activity we community calendar for drug free need to assign someone to post that information on that site. RCM's should know what is going on in their areas new years eve. A upsetting thing for me to report is that the Florida Service Symposium is being held the same weekend as GRCNA in Tampa Fla. There is no reason to contact them at this time because the ball is already rolling and locked in. I sent them a e-mail stating my disappointment and I received one back on how long in advance they planned this function. We can decide at this Region what action to take since myself and the RDA have a GSR workshop planned for the convention and I have already paid my hotel and registration for our convention.

Lastly, I received a shipment of literature from Maryland that was earmarked for our region and I think Mary Ellen knows about that, so I will give it to her. That concludes my report and thank you for letting me serve.

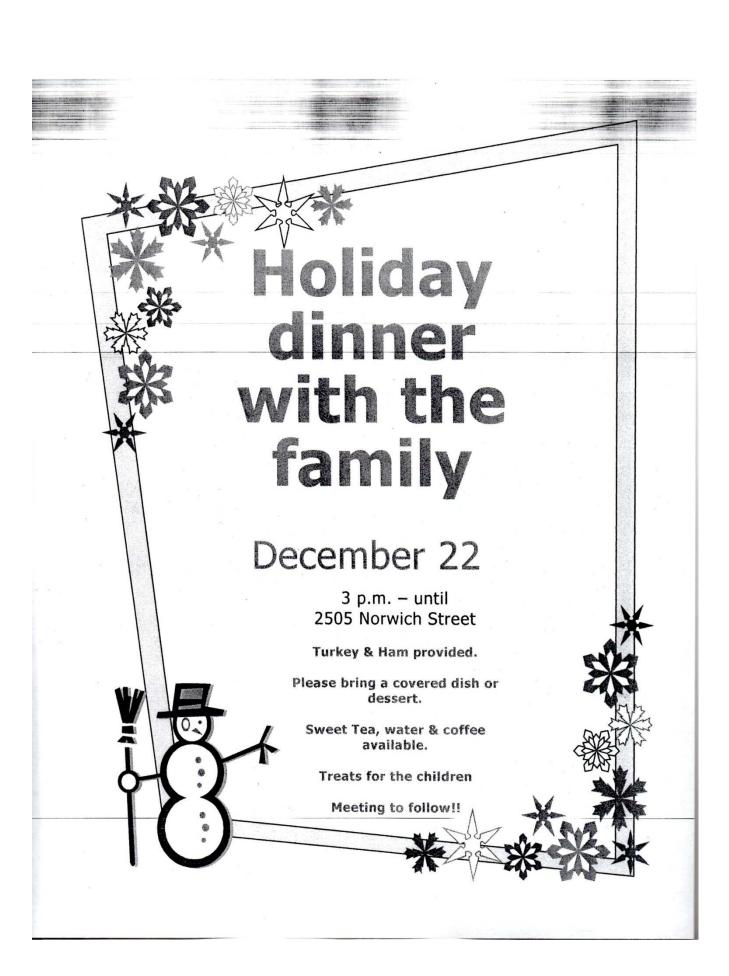

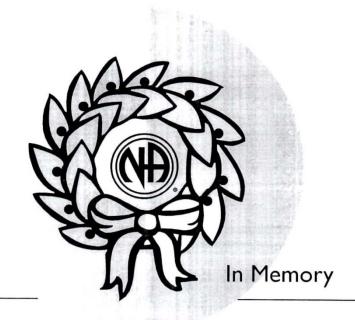

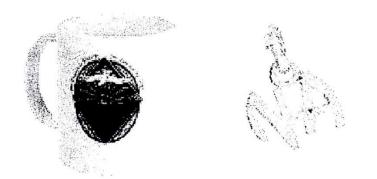
